You have strong experience in economic development or allied fields and a firm commitment to inclusion and economic justice. You have the ability to think both critically and creatively, generating new ideas and new ways of working. You have demonstrated skills in research, stakeholder engagement, and peer learning models. You are an excellent writer and communicator with the ability to deliver complex insights to a variety of audiences. You have the capacity to rapidly acquire new knowledge, the organizational and time management skills to balance multiple projects concurrently, and the ability to work as member of a team in a low-structure environment. Finally, you may have a degree in economic development, economics or urban planning/policy or you may have come into the field of inclusive economic development through lived experience.

The salary for this role is commensurate with experience, ranging from \$85,000 - \$95,000.
